Site investigations on Bellevue Street, Tempe from Wednesday 12 June

Sydney Gateway will provide a new alternative route to enhance connections and reduce travel times to Sydney's ports.

Roads and Maritime Services will be carrying out additional geotechnical investigations in Tempe to gather information about environmental and ground conditions. These investigations are next to Inner West Council's storage depot on the corner of Bellevue Street and Swamp Road.

Your property was previously notified of the original works, and these are additional investigations in the same area, that will occur between **Wednesday 12 June - Friday 20 September,** weather permitting.

These investigations are part of the geotechnical and environmental investigations being carried out at various locations for Sydney Gateway.

The investigations require the drilling of a borehole, using portable drill rigs. These works should take around one to two day or night shifts to drill.

Previous wells will continue to be monitored each month. The new work area has been identified on the map over the page.

Our work schedule

Work hours are between:

- Monday to Friday, 7am and 6pm
- Saturday, 8am and 1pm

However, some of the work may be required at night between 8pm to 6am weekdays.














How will the work affect you?
