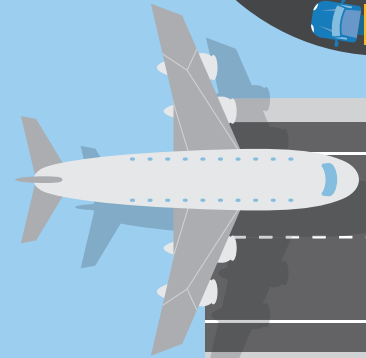




Sydney Gateway

**Site investigations in Tempe East,
from Thursday 20 June**



Sydney Gateway will provide a new alternative route to enhance connections and reduce travel times to Sydney's ports.

We will be carrying out additional geotechnical investigations in Tempe to gather information about environmental and ground conditions. We will be working at multiple locations in Tempe between **Thursday 20 June - Friday 4 October**, weather permitting.

The investigations require the drilling of boreholes, installing groundwater wells and sampling existing groundwaters wells.

The work areas are shown on the map over the page.

Our work schedule

Work hours are between:

- **Monday to Friday, 7am and 6pm**
- **Saturday, 8am and 1pm**

However, some of the work may be required at night between 8pm to 6am weekdays.
